



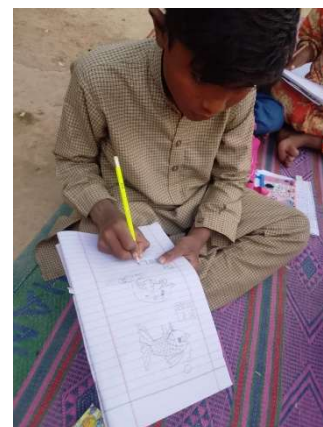

## Redeeming Sagar



Sagar is an 18-year-old young man who has been studying at Rain Academy, our school in Faisalabad. He had been working in a nearby pizzeria where he was able to support himself, however, his father died in debt and that debt is now requires Sagar to work in slavery, giving up his job and education. Sagar's servitude involves dying textiles. He is provided no protection against the harsh chemicals which are damaging the skin on his hands and feet. Sagar is a dedicated Christian and his faith is pulling him through this difficult time. Sagar remains committed to continued learning and wants to become a chef and run his own restaurant one day. He is able to return to work in the pizzeria if he is able to obtain redemption from slavery relatively quickly. For this reason, everyone has come together around Sagar – his freedom would be the greatest Christmas gift this year according to his peers at Rain Academy. And so, Sagar has become one of CMI's highest priorities this year. We are in dire need of financial support and organizations receptive to our presentations. ## Redeeming Kashish



Kashish is a beautiful young lady who has grown up receiving education through Rain Academy in Faisalabad. She will be 20 years old in January. Kashish dreams of continuing her education and becoming a fashion designer one day. Kashish is fortunate in that both her parents are still living – her father works as a street sweeper, and her mother works as a servant in a Muslim household. Together, her parents make about \$40.00 a month in their menial labor. In addition to parents, her family also consists of five sisters who are also students in our academy. Due to dire poverty, Kashish's father has promised her out to work as a servant in a Muslim home in exchange for money needed to repair the family's home. Consequently, Kashish is now obligated and enslaved. At first, the work was tolerable, but recently Kashish has fallen victim to sexual abuse at the hands of her master. In this situation, Kashish has absolutely no recourse. For this reason, Kashish has been placed on our fast track for redemption from slavery. Please consider how you can help us redeem Kashish.


## A Job for Eliza

Eliza has recently graduated from Rain Academy and has enrolled in the local university. Eliza is a bright and beautiful young lady who has just recently celebrated her eighteenth birthday. She is a devout Christian and is studying to become a pastor. Eliza comes from a poor background, her mother has been gone for several years and her father's new wife prioritizes her younger half-siblings over Eliza. Therefore, Eliza has relied on our ministry for support over the past several years. In order to help Eliza support herself and continue in her education, CMI has hired her on as a teacher for our younger class of students. Her job with us will enable her to pay college tuition and for transportation to and from the university. In Addition, she will be able to help her family by supporting herself. In this way, we are able to help her entire household. Wherever we can, we prefer to put our people to work for themselves at good salaries. Your support helps us do this.
